For the last three months of 2016, the Colonial Shag Club will be very busy. On October 1st, we will have a Special Meeting for members to vote on amending the Articles of Incorporation that are on file with the State Corporation Commission. This will update the Articles of Incorporation to agree with the revised Bylaws that were voted on and approved by the members on November 14, 2015.



On October 22nd, nominations for the 2017 Board of Directors will be announced. For those of you who would like to serve on the Board for 2017, please contact Committee Chair, Colette Quinn, or committee members Janice McGrew, Kim Downing, Bob McCreary, and Brickey Hughes.

Also on October 22nd, we will have our second Charity Dance of 2016 for the Menchville House. The Menchville House started in April of 1998 as a temporary home for women and their children, and in 2002 the Colonial Shag Club made them the club's charity to support. The Menchville House is now a temporary home for homeless families. Their mission statement is "*To help homeless families return to self-sufficiency by providing a temporary home and supportive services.*" In 2002, when club had approximately 35 to 45 members, we raised \$1,000 for Menchville House. Since then, we have continued to support our charity every year. In the last few years we have held two charity dances a year in hopes of raising more money for Menchville House. Please come out and support our charity dance on October 22nd for this worthy cause.

The club's annual Halloween Party will be on October 29th. Please feel free to wear your favorite costume and maybe bring a snack or dessert to

share. This has always proven to be a fun event for our members.
