- We will have our 13th annual Christmas Party and Dance on December 16th.


That's a lot of dancing and partying for the rest of 2017.

It has become more difficult for our regular five deejays to be available for our Saturday night dances, and we have frequently had to call on substitute deejays to fill in. I feel certain the deejays will play where they know what they will be payed instead of playing for the Colonial Shag Club where they are uncertain of what they will earn by only being payed from the tip jar. If attendance is good, the deejays usually get enough for their efforts. If attendance is low, the deejay may be poorly compensated for spending nearly five hours playing music for the dance lessons and our dancing. Those who attend our Saturday night dances should keep in mind that we are blessed with very talented deejays, and I strongly recommend that everyone contribute to the tip jar when it is passed around so we can properly compensate our deejays. As much as I hate to say this, if we don't do a better job of supporting the deejays with your tips, we may have to increase the cost of admission in order to see that everyone contributes to deejay compensation.

I thank Dianne Ligon who won the 50/50 drawing of \$97 on Saturday June 24th and donated it back to the club.


